This guide provides an overview of the schools in the city of Heilbronn. It explains the different types of school and lists the relevant schools and their specialisms. It also outlines possible educational pathways within the German school system. When making your decision, bear in mind that in Germany, every school-leaving qualification opens the door to a range of further education and training pathways.

We encourage you to use the information and advice offered by schools. If you would like support in your native language, the Parent Ambassadors (EMUs in German) are on hand to offer free support and will be happy to accompany you to your appointments. You can find more information on this on page 8 of this guide.

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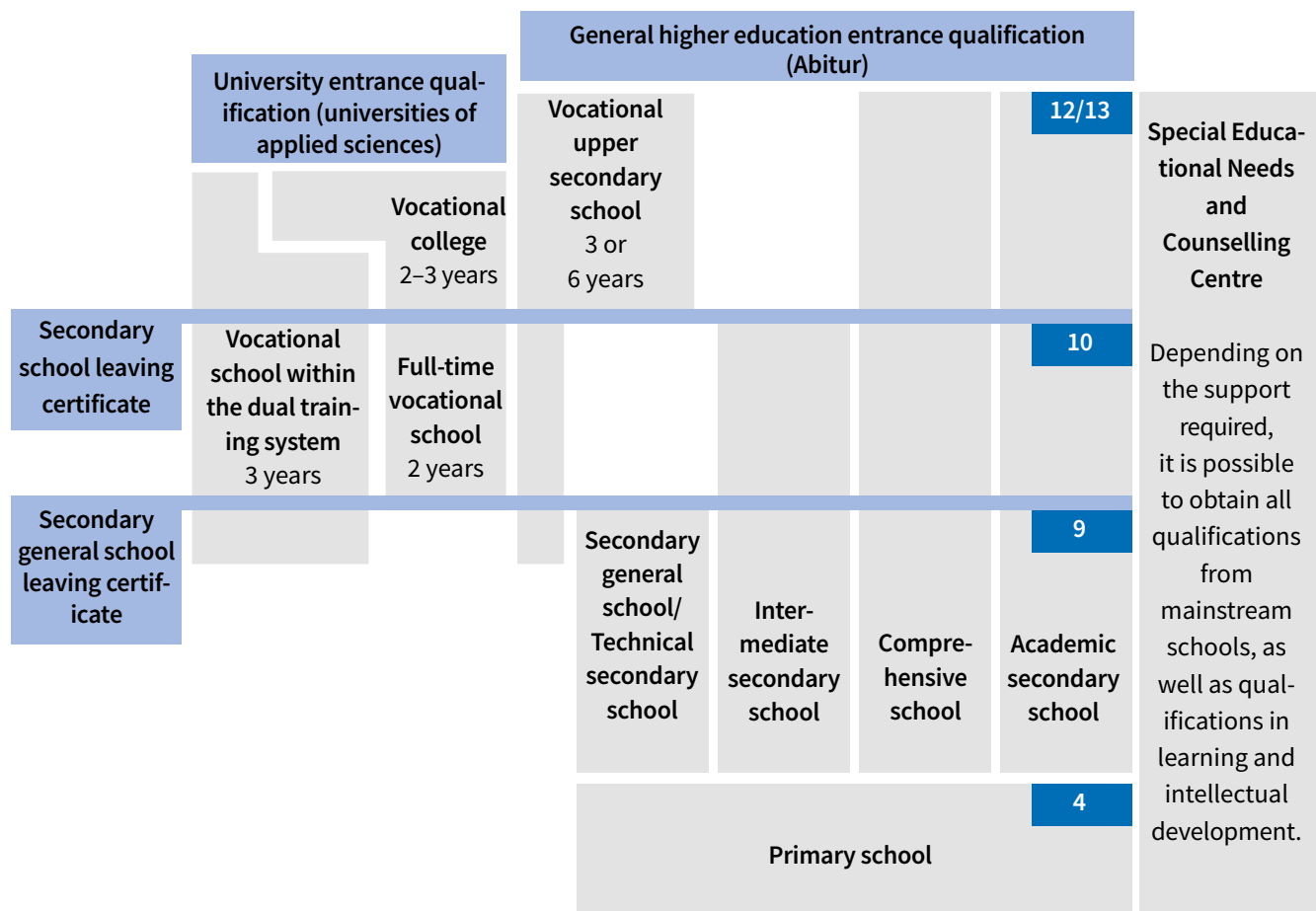
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# General Information

- **Enrolment:** You must enrol your child directly at the school. You will need your child's **birth certificate**, **ID card/passport**, **proof of measles vaccination**, and your own ID card/passport.
- **Parents' evening:** At parents' evenings, you will get to know your child's teachers and receive important information.
- **Holidays:** The dates of school holidays are fixed. They must not be started earlier or extended. You can obtain the holiday timetable from your child's school. Many schools offer holiday childcare; make sure you find out about this in good time.
- **Public holidays:** In Germany, schools are closed on major Christian holidays such as Easter and Christmas. You can apply to the school for a day off for other important religious holidays.
- **All-day schools:** Unlike primary schools, not all secondary schools offer all-day supervision. All technical intermediate secondary schools and comprehensive schools operate as all-day schools on at least three days a week.
- **Primary school recommendation:** At the start of the second term of Year 4, your child will receive a primary school recommendation. However, parents have the final decision regarding the school (other than academic secondary school). Even though the recommendation is not binding, you must submit it to the secondary school when you enrol. Special rules apply to admission to academic secondary schools.
- **Homework:** Many schools offer homework supervision. Help your child by making sure they do their homework.
- **Information events:** All secondary schools offer sessions to help you get to know the school. Information is available from the primary schools and on the schools' websites.
- **Costs:** In Germany, attendance at state schools is free of charge. There are always expenses for trips or special events. The school will let you know in good time.
- **Illness:** If your child is ill, you are obliged to notify the school. The school will tell you how to do this.
- **Measles vaccination:** Children must provide proof that they have been vaccinated against measles in order to be admitted to the school. If your child has not yet been vaccinated, the school will provide you with information on where you can arrange for them to be vaccinated.
- **Materials:** You can obtain information about the materials (school bags, exercise books, sportswear, etc.) from the school. The textbooks your child receives from school are on loan. Please ensure that these are not damaged and are returned at the end of the school year.
- **Lunch:** Many schools provide a canteen where pupils can get an affordable lunch. You can find further information on this on the pages for the respective school type.
- **Compulsory schooling:** All children in Germany **must** attend school. As parents or guardians, you are responsible for ensuring that your child fulfils this obligation. School trips, hiking days and physical education lessons are also part of this **compulsory schooling**.
- **You don't speak much German?** Volunteer interpreters are available for parent-teacher meetings; the school will arrange them for you. For further information, see page 8.
- **Secondary schools:** After Year 4 of primary school, children move on to schools at different levels.

# Starting school with little or no knowledge of German:

## Preparatory classes (VKL in German)

Are you new to Germany? Children who do not yet speak German at all, or who do not speak it well enough to follow lessons, attend what are known as preparatory classes, or VKL for short, for a period of time. Places on the VKL courses are allocated by the Clearing Office of the Department of Education, Culture and Sport.

The Clearing Centre acts as an intermediary between those seeking school places and schools, facilitating placements in preparatory classes at primary and intermediate secondary schools, as well as in the pre-qualification year for work and careers (VABO in German) at vocational schools for those without German language skills.

The school placement service is used by immigrant families from the EU, as well as by refugee families and the legal guardians responsible for unaccompanied minor foreigners (UMAs in German).

In primary education (ages 6 to 10), pupils are usually allocated a place at a school in the catchment area where they live.

In the VKL sector of intermediate secondary schools (ages 10 to 15), central student registration takes place once a month at the Dammrealschule in Heilbronn. Following an admission interview and a review of the pupils' educational background, various tests in mathematics and English are conducted.

With the involvement of the clearing house, recommendations are then drawn up for various types of school (technical secondary school, intermediate secondary school, comprehensive school, academic secondary school) and pupils are placed in a suitable school.

In July, a central registration and testing process takes place at a vocational school for young people aged between 15 and 19 who are due to start the preparatory year for work and employment without German language skills (VABO). If you arrive in Heilbronn during the school year, school placements will be arranged through the Clearing Centre at the Heilbronn Education Office.

# Special educational needs and counselling centres

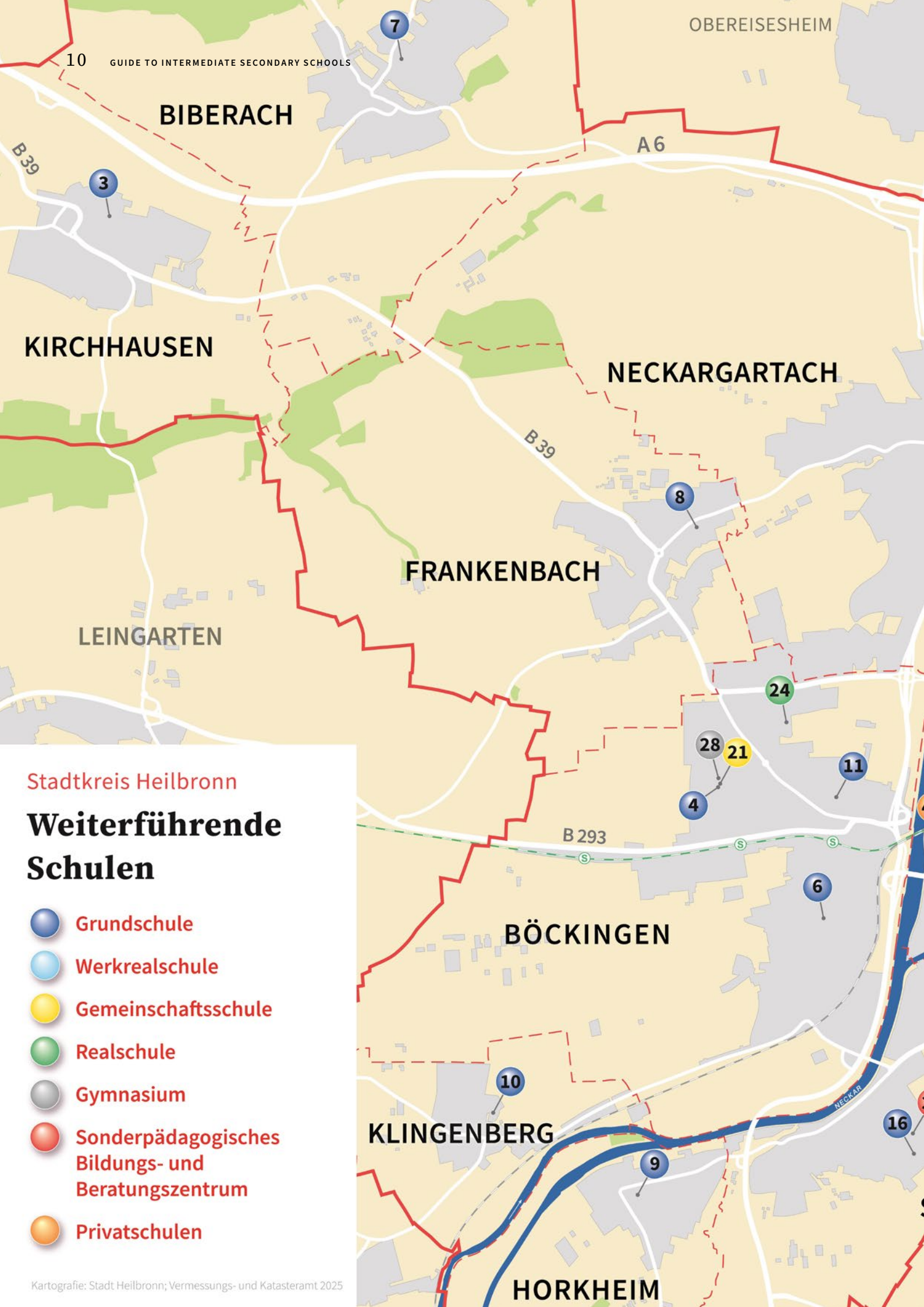
These schools specialise in educating children with disabilities. They focus on different educational areas and offer not only specialised teaching but also specific therapy and support services.

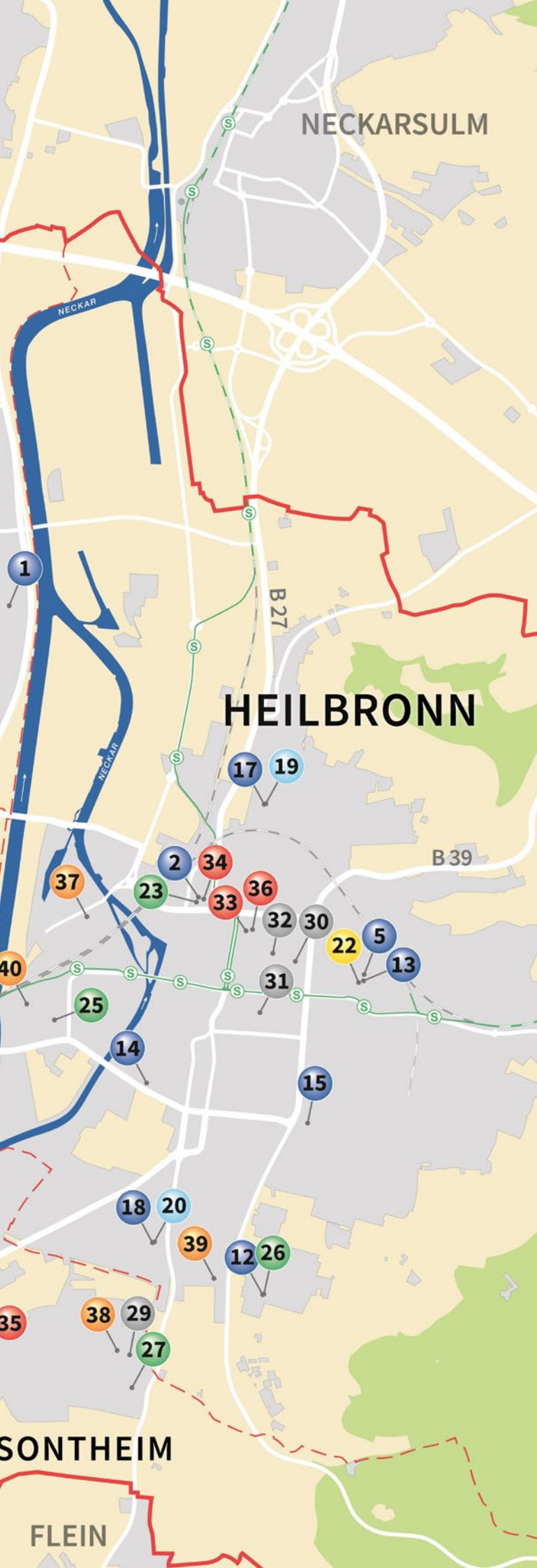

# Technical secondary schools (Werkrealschulen)

Technical intermediate secondary schools provide a basic and extended general education, focusing on real-life situations and tasks.

Technical intermediate secondary schools offer the opportunity to obtain the secondary school leaving certificate after Year 9.

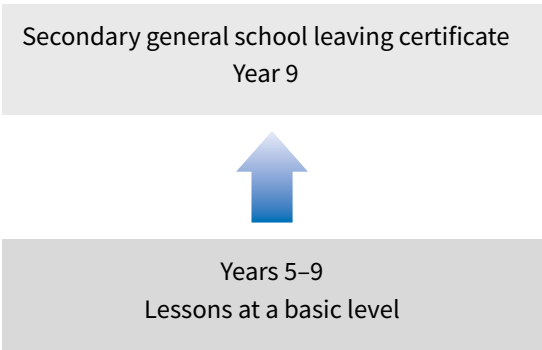
Technical intermediate secondary schools are all-day schools with afternoon lessons on 3–4 days a week. They offer a wide range of extracurricular clubs and activities. Your child can eat lunch in the canteen.

Technical intermediate secondary schools have a strong vocational focus. Career guidance begins at an early stage.

# Intermediate secondary schools (Realschulen)

Intermediate secondary schools are the tried-and-tested type of school for obtaining an intermediate secondary school leaving certificate. It is also possible to leave intermediate secondary schools with a secondary general school leaving certificate. The intermediate secondary school leaving certificate provides a solid foundation for a vocational apprenticeship as well as for further education pathways such as vocational academic secondary school. Lessons take place in class groups. Performance is assessed, among other things, through graded class tests, school reports with grades, and, from Year 6 onwards, decisions on whether pupils will progress to the next year.

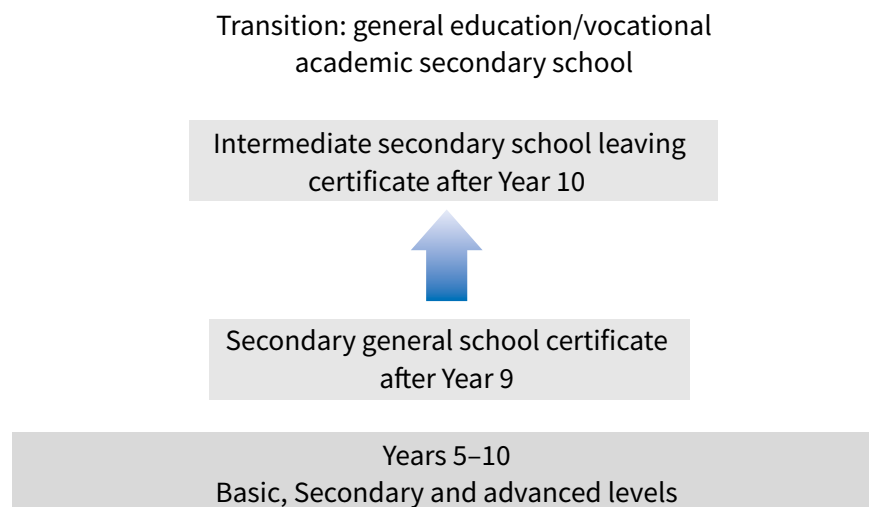
# Comprehensive schools (Gemeinschaftsschulen)

Comprehensive schools are high-achieving schools that challenge and support children and young people with different abilities in mixed-ability learning groups. Teaching at comprehensive schools follows the educational standards of secondary general schools, intermediate secondary schools and academic secondary schools. This makes it possible to teach different subjects at different levels.

The same final exams are held at comprehensive schools as at general education schools. Provided the relevant criteria are met, pupils may transfer to the upper school of a comprehensive school, a general education school or a vocational academic secondary school. Verbal feedback on assessments of learning objectives, as well as regular coaching and learning progress discussions, replace grades. Learning progress reports replace traditional school reports. No one is held back a year at comprehensive schools. Comprehensive schools are compulsory all-day schools. Lessons and practical sessions take place at school.

# Academic secondary schools (Gymnasien)

General education academic secondary schools lead to the German Abitur (general university entrance qualification) after nine years, which entitles students to study at any higher education institution or university. Upon progression to Year 10, pupils are awarded the secondary general school leaving certificate; upon progression to Year 11, they are awarded the secondary school leaving certificate. General education academic secondary schools achieve these objectives through a wide-ranging curriculum that includes German, mathematics, at least two foreign languages, social sciences, natural sciences, arts and music, and physical education. Teaching, assessments and grading are carried out consistently and exclusively at the advanced level, known as the E-level. Pupils are expected to take a keen interest in school matters and to be highly motivated. A good command of German is essential for a successful school career.
